Frontier Airlines Provides Low Fare Service From Wilmington, Delaware

*Nonstop service to five new markets with fares as low as \$49 thru April 20
only at FlyFrontier.com*

*Low cost convenience for Wilmington, South Philly and the Delmarva
Peninsula*

DENVER (April 9, 2013) – Frontier Airlines today announced it will bring its friendly brand of low-fare air service to Wilmington/Philadelphia New Castle Airport in Wilmington, DE starting July 1, 2013. Frontier will offer five new nonstop routes on 168-seat Airbus A320 aircraft to Chicago-Midway, Denver, Houston, Orlando, and Tampa, as well as offer connecting service via Denver to destinations across the west. Frontier will be the only airline providing scheduled service from Wilmington/Philadelphia Airport, just a short drive from downtown Philadelphia.

This expansion comes on the heels of Frontier's recent entry into Trenton, NJ, where Frontier now offers ten destinations. Frontier seeks to duplicate its success at Trenton-Mercer Airport in Ewing, NJ by bringing low fares to customers who live south of Philadelphia with convenient and complementary service from Wilmington/Philadelphia Airport.

Customers traveling on Frontier's new routes from Wilmington/Philadelphia will find the best fares, more choice and better perks when booking on Frontier's website FlyFrontier.com. Customers flying the new routes to or from Wilmington/Philadelphia can register to earn triple *EarlyReturns*® frequent flier miles** for all flights in July 2013 and double miles*** for all flights in August and September 2013. "We hope Delawareans will take advantage of the convenience of having an airline service so close to home," said Governor Jack Markell. "Bringing this new business to our state is a welcomed economic opportunity to provide new travel options for Delawareans."

"Commercial passenger air service in and out of Delaware is something we've been without for far too long," U.S. Senator Chris Coons said. "This is exciting news. The convenience and value that Delawareans will enjoy by having a full-service airline in New Castle County is significant, reducing travel time on the ground and ticket costs in the air. I'm grateful that Frontier has chosen to invest in Delaware and look forward to taking advantage of this new opportunity."

I'm excited to see travelers once again flying into and out of New Castle County Airport."

This new service will operate on spacious 168-seat Airbus 320 aircraft, which offer more customer amenities, including 30 channels of DIRECTV service available at every seat. Additionally, all Wilmington/Philadelphia flights will offer six rows of comfortable STRETCH seating with an additional five-seven inches of legroom, and the airline's SELECT seating product. Frontier's website, FlyFrontier.com, offers the guaranteed best fares and is the only place STRETCH and SELECT seating is available at the time of booking.

At Wilmington/Philadelphia Airport, Frontier customers can avoid the hassles and lines of airports like Baltimore and Philadelphia. The airport offers affordable parking, transit service on Dart Routes 22 and 25 to downtown Wilmington and the Amtrak/SEPTA station plus convenient access to Avis and Budget

rental cars. Wilmington/Philadelphia Airport is just 38 miles from downtown Philadelphia, and 45 miles from the Delaware State Capitol in Dover, making the airport a convenient gateway to these cities.

***Terms and Conditions: Introductory Fares for Wilmington Service**

Tickets for sale fares must be purchased by 11:59 p.m. Eastern time, April 20, 2013. Fares for Wilmington, DE to/from Chicago (Midway), IL and Houston, TX are for travel July 1, 2013, through November 13, 2013; fares for Wilmington, DE to/from Denver, CO and Orlando, FL are for travel July 2, 2013 through November 13, 2013; and fares for Wilmington, DE to/from Tampa, FL are for travel July 4, 2013 through November 13, 2013. Fares are one way. Roundtrip purchase not required. Seats are limited at these fares and certain flights and/or days of travel may be unavailable, especially during busy travel periods. Tickets are nonrefundable, but depending on the fare type purchased may be transferred for \$50 or reissued for alternate flights for \$50, as well as a possible fare increase to a non-promotional fare type. The name change fee and itinerary change fee are not exclusive of each other. Previously purchased tickets may not be exchanged for these special fare tickets. Flight segment(s) must be cancelled prior to scheduled departure time or the ticket(s) and all monies will be forfeited.

Fares reflect purchase at FlyFrontier.com.
