I. POSITION SUMMARY

Perform any and all duties assigned by Port Engineer, Senior Manager Marine Mechanics or Marine Mechanics Manager. Required to work independently and assist other trades. Responsible for following established safety practices while performing assigned duties to protect self, co-workers and the public from personal injury and to prevent damage to Authority property. This position is a bargaining unit position that is represented by the Marine Engineers' Beneficial Association (MEBA).

II. ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Cleaning shop and other work areas on vessels
- Assist mechanics, welders or electricians in performance of their jobs including painting, cleaning parts, running errands and safety lookout
- Pick up and deliver parts, use of motor vehicles, use of a fork lift
- Clean equipment or vehicles
- Perform tasks directed by supervisors, mechanics, electricians or welders
- The use of all types of mechanical hand tools as well as the use of air and electrically operated hand tools such as drills, grinders and saws
- The use of painting equipment and use of a pressure washer
- Provides the highest level of customer service and professionalism to all internal and external customers

II. REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

- Basic knowledge of all types of hand tools and must have good mechanical aptitude
- Ability to understand written and oral instructions
- Physical coordination and moderate strength for heavier jobs
- Ability to provide superior customer service
