A public bid opening was held on May 25, 2022, in which (2) bids were submitted.

The COO recommended awarding the contract, in the amount of \$858,650.00 to Detwiler Roofing.

• DMB-21-08 Lane Signal Indicators Replacement

A public bid opening was held on May 24, 2022, in which (2) bids were submitted.

The COO recommended awarding the contract, in the amount of \$1,299,850.00 to McLean Contracting Co.

• MIV-21-07 Building M-17 Roof Improvements

A public bid opening was held on May 25, 2022, in which (3) bids were submitted.

The COO recommended awarding the contract, in the amount of \$524,745.00 to Noble Roofing & Sheet Metal Inc.

• ILG-21-08 Building I-6000 Upgrades

A public bid opening was held on May 24, 2022, in which (3) bids were submitted.

The COO recommended awarding the contract, in the amount of \$168,567.00 to L.J. Paolella Construction, Inc.

ILG-21-09 Building I-1011 Roof Improvements

A public bid opening was held on June 2, 2022, in which (2) bids were submitted.

The COO recommended awarding the contract, in the amount of \$171,200.00 to Detwiler Roofing.

Committee Chair Ransome called for a motion to accept the (7) awards, to which Commissioner Becker made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Faust and Projects Committee concurred with the recommendation to accept and authorize the action to be presented to the full Board at the June meeting later today.

5. Contractor Payment Reviews:

The COO reviewed for the Committee the monthly construction contractor payment summary to be made for the work completed through May 2021 for (14) payments totaling approximately \$6 million for projects at the bridge, ferry, and airports.

6. Discussion Items

• New Ferry Vessels

Committee Chair Ransome reviewed the Committee's findings on the purchase of new ferry vessels. At this time, the Committee feels more research on finances and the objectives of the DRBA is needed. Therefore, no decision has been made. The initial recommendation for five 55-vehicle does not appear to be financially feasible. In addition, the pilots are not supporting the smaller vessels; they recommend the two 75/100 vehicle. A survey was conducted to which it was determined, 95% of the travelers do exit their vehicles while on the Ferry; therefore, the size is important. Finances are the deciding factor. Committee Chair feels two 75-vehicle ferries are the viable option.

Chairman Hogan expressed concern with ridership with the near-by New Jersey counties population declining. Co-Chair noted since most are vacationers, this should not affect it. The CFO reviewed the effects on the DRBA's credit rating with a diversion of funds from the bridges to the ferries; yet, if grants are obtained, this will soften the financial stress of the bridge itself. Commissioner Baldini inquired as to how much time is given to utilize the grants to which the COO noted 5 years. She also inquired if there is a fuel alternative to which the COO noted at this time, electric and solar are not an option as our facilities do not generate enough of neither. Commissioner Wilson inquired of the length of time to construct the ferries to which the COO noted 18 months for design plus 24 months for actual construction.

• Construction Projects Progress

The monthly construction highlights report was previously presented via email to the Commissioners. The COO asked if there were any questions on that report. There were none. The COO presented to the Board an informational handout on the DMB Deck Overlay Project. This will be shared with the public at the EZ Pass customer service desks, electronically to EZPass holders in addition to the various media outlets.

7. With no further business to discuss, Committee Chair Ransome called for a motion to adjourn; Commissioner Becker made a motion and Vice-Chair Ratchford seconded, and the Projects Committee adjourned at 12:36 p.m.
