- 1. **08:45 AM** departure for customers taking the **12:00 PM** rail biking tour
- 2. 10:15 AM departure for customers taking the 2:00 PM rail biking tour

Customers can choose either the **4:30 PM** or **6:00 PM** return ferry departure from Cape May, which must be selected at the time of booking to reserve shuttle space.

- Infant: **\$90.00** (Infants MUST be able to sit in their own seat unassisted)
