I. POSITION SUMMARY

This position is a /casual marine position which includes upkeep of all vessels and related equipment in accordance with the Captain's and/or Pilot's, Boatswain's instructions. Most job responsibilities require little or no previous skills. Required to hose, buff, swab, sweep, and scrub the vessel as well as monitor passenger access/egress areas for safety and integrity. This position is required to work safely and efficiently in accordance with instructions, general operating practices, and procedures. Work is focused on immediate unit with limited awareness of related areas. Work schedules can be modified to fit the departmental needs which may require the employee to work shift work and/or weekends. Work is performed indoors/outdoors and can be in any weather condition. This casual position is part-time with no guaranteed minimum number of hours, nor are there any guaranteed assignments.

I. ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Proper cleaning of vessel's bathrooms
- Trash removal from the vessel on every arrival
- Cleaning and polishing brass/stainless surfaces/windows
- Snow removal and salting to maintain safe footing aboard the vessel
- Other duties as assigned
- Provides the highest level of customer service and professionalism to all internal and external customers
- Contributes to the safe operation of vessels and equipment
- Responds decisively and effectively to emergency situations

- Ability to understand relevant Authority policies and procedures and safety techniques
- Ability to traverse inclined and vertical ramps and ladders
